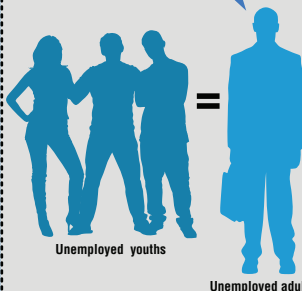

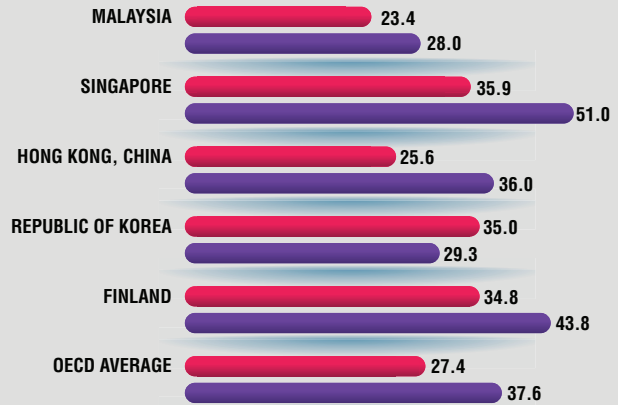

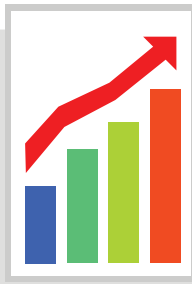
**EDUCATION AND SKILL LEVELS OF LABOUR FORCE,
MALAYSIA V.S. SELECTED ECONOMIES**



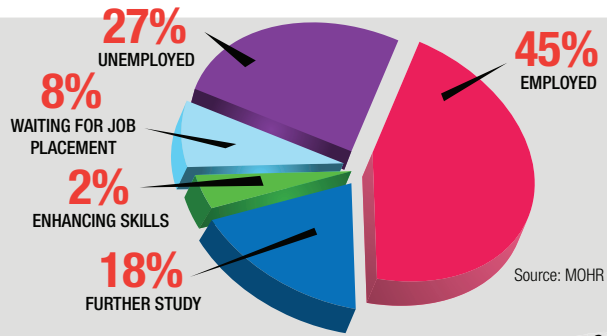
● Labour force with Tertiary Education (%) 2007

● Soled labour force (%) 2008

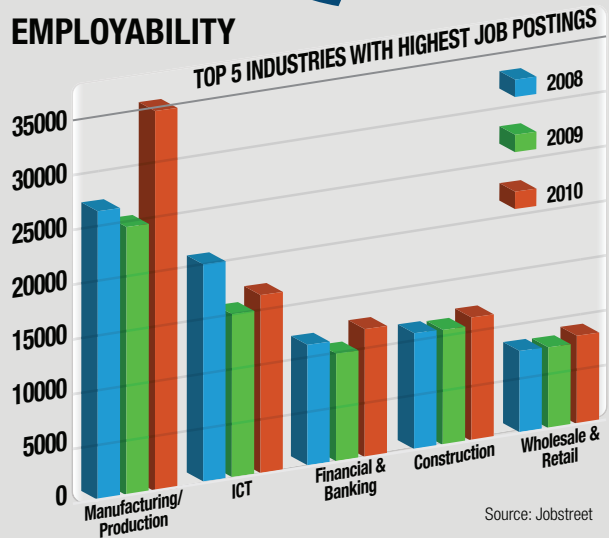
